

## REQUEST TO TAKE UNLISTED EAST ASIAN COURSES

Students in the East Asian Studies MA program must take 10 graduate-level courses; those pursuing the thesis option must take 6 courses related to East Asia, those pursuing the non-thesis option must take 8 courses related to East Asia. Approved courses can be found on the [APSI website](#). If a course is not listed as an East Asian course, students may seek the approval from the DGS to count the course toward the East Asian requirement if at least 1/3 of the graded work focuses on East Asia.

The student must complete the form below, obtain the signature of the DGS and submit the form along with the course syllabus to DGSA, Alex Nickley ([alexander.nickley@duke.edu](mailto:alexander.nickley@duke.edu)) no later than two business days before the conclusion of the drop/add period. The student must also submit the work to Alex Nickley by the end of the semester, demonstrating content requirements have been fulfilled.
